Sisters in El Salvador: Comings and Goings

In February Sister Eleanor Gilmore returned to the United States from El Salvador where she had founded PazSalud, a healthcare volunteer ministry made possible through a collaboration of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Peace and PeaceHealth

the healthcare system founded by the Sisters. For nine years, Sister Eleanor directed the program with Kathy Garcia of PeaceHealth, organizing the work of volunteers in individual missions and PeaceHealth sponsored clinics for Salvadorans. Months before Sister Eleanor came home, Sister Susan Dewitt was doing both on and off the job training in order to assume the PazSalud ministry. Since January she has been in El Salvador as the in-country coordinator; Kathy Garcia continues to guide the PazSalud mission as Program Director. Recently, the base house for the mission was moved to Suchitoto, a picturesque town about 30 miles north of San Salvador.

The El Salvador Health Mission provides the opportunity for PeaceHealth and the CSJP Community, through volunteer participation of employees and CSJP affiliates, to bring human and material resources to people in a country with inadequate health care.

Many Salvadorans live in poverty- particularly in rural areas - with little or no access to the limited services provided by the government and non-governmental organizations. Susan is enjoying her new work, particularly now that she has been joined by Sister Margaret Jane Kling who worked in El Salvador during the civil war in the 1980s.

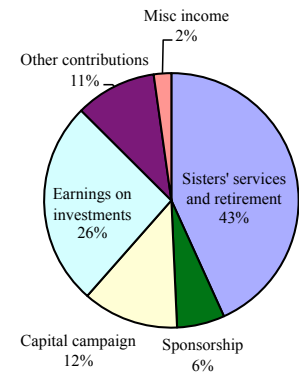

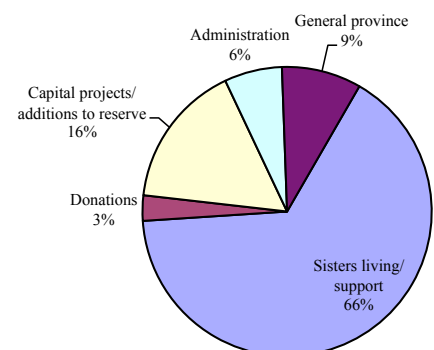

ANNUAL FUND GIFT CATEGORIES

Margaret Anna Cusack (Mother Clare)

Writer, historian, Irishwoman, passionate advocate for the poor, Margaret Anna found the Sisters of St. Joseph of Peace in 1884.

Mother Evangelista Gaffney

One of the first Sisters of St. Joseph of Peace, Sister Evangelista entered the new community of January 7th, 1884 in Nottingham Cathedral. Honored as CSJP co-founder, she nurtured the infant community.

Sister Teresa Moran

Sister Teresa was one of our Northwest pioneers, arriving in Bellingham in 1890. She presided over the building of the original St. Joseph Hospital. Sister Teresa served as Mother General of the Congregation for 17 years.

Sister Jane Frances Lowery

As nurse and administrator, Sister Jane Frances ministered in many of our hospitals. As Provincial Superior, she guided the 1955 purchase of St. Mary-on-the-Lake, Bellevue.

Sister Hildegarde McMahon

An educator, Sister Hildegarde taught in schools in British Columbia, Washington and New Jersey. She was Provincial Superior when the present complex of residences and commons was built at St. Mary-on-the-Lake in 1963.

Sister Theodore Marie Gorman

As nurse and administrator, Sister Theodore Marie guided the development of Sacred Heart Hospital, Eugene, OR. She served as Province Leader from 1955-61 and 1964-68, during periods of renewal and change in religious life.

Sister Joan Leonard

As educator for many years, Sister Joan Leonard was one of the first principals of Sacred heart School, Bellevue, WA. She was a founder of Jubilee Women's Center, providing housing and hope for homeless women in Seattle since 1983.
